Congratulations to parents and seniors. You are quickly approaching a tremendous milestone in your life. Graduation commencement has been set for Tuesday, May 23rd at 7 p.m. on the Tiger football stadium (weather permitting). Gates will open promptly at 5:30 p.m. and ushers will be available to assist with seating. **NO RESERVED**SEATING WILL BE ALLOWED. Gold tickets are reserved for seating in the chairs on the track and black tickets are reserved for seating in the bleachers sectioned off by ropes. The number of tickets has yet to be determined; however, it will not be less than last year. There will be at least 2 tickets for the seats on the track and 4 for the bleacher section per family. Public seating will be on the furthest outside bleachers on both ends of the stadium, grass areas and silver bleachers on the top level by the press box. No tickets are necessary in public seating. We have a graduating class this year of 226 grads, which is larger than last year. We have been able to accommodate all families by using the extra tickets from those families who don't need all of their tickets. Please consider turning in your extra tickets to the main office so that we may accommodate those with larger families. Thank you in advance for your understanding.

Handicap-reserved seating is in the front row with parking on the upper level along the fence and lower level for wheel chairs. A golf cart will be assisting handicap guests to seats as needed. Handicapped seating does not require a ticket.
